PTA President – Kathy Parzygnat

- Welcome, introductions, distributed raffle tickets.
- The next item of business is the election of officers, according to Article 6 of the NCPTA Uniform Bylaws. This year's Nominating Committee is Jodi Bulmer (Chair), Morgan Blue, and Jennifer Lee.
  - Jodi Bulmer, Nominating Committee Chair, submitted the following nominations for the West Millbrook Magnet Middle School PTA officers for the 2023-2024 school year:

VP of Fundraising – Julie Karg

- Our next Spirit Night: Goodberry's in late May or early June.

Treasurer's Report – Jodi Bulmer

- Reconciled bank account on 4/30 balance is \$29,052.41.
- Two Budget proposals for consideration:
  - 1) WMMMS PTA membership dues increase: In December 2022, the National PTA Board of Directors proposed a new dues rate of \$4.00 (a \$1.75 adjustment per

membership). In this regard, the WMMMS PTA proposed the following membership dues increases for the 2023-24 school year: \$7/Faculty (currently \$5) and \$12/General Membership (currently \$10).

2) Proposed a new model to allocate funds for end of year events: The current allocation has not been changed since 2012 and should be adjusted to meet inflation costs. The newly proposed model to allocate funds for end of year events is:

- i) Year 1, increase from \$750/yr to \$1K/yr
- ii) Year 2, increase from \$750/yr to \$1K/yr
- Year 3, change the model to a per student cost. If we budget \$10 per event (dance, picnic, ceremony), this would allocate \$30 per student.
- Motion was made to approve by Julie Karg.
- Seconded by Alice Martinson.
- Quorum was met and the Budget was amended with no dissent.
- Proposed a motion to open an Operational Reserve Account at First Citizens Bank.
  - Motion was made to approve by Warren Holman.
  - Seconded by Julie Karg.
  - Quorum was met and motion was approved with no dissent.
